Dear Mr. Minister,

I have the honour to refer to my letter dated 8 November 2010, inviting you to participate in a meeting, under my chairmanship, to be convened at the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) European and North Atlantic Regional Office in Paris at 1000 hours on Monday, 13 December 2010. I firmly believe that a meeting between you, myself and Dr. Erato Kozakou-Marcoullis, Minister of Communications and Works, Republic of Cyprus, is a critical step toward improving safety of international civil aviation in the northern part of the Nicosia flight information region.

I wish to reiterate ICAO's preparedness to assist in finding a solution to the ongoing situation between Cyprus and Turkey with regards to provision of air navigation services, and in this respect I have a number of proposals I would appreciate the opportunity to bring to your attention. These proposals, in my view, can improve safety within and proximate to the affected airspace.

Mr. Minister, it is with some urgency that I now request a response to the invitation. Dr. Erato Kozakou-Marcoullis has responded positively to the invitation and will be in attendance. Further administrative arrangements, however, need to be made, and it is with this in mind I ask that you respond by 6 December 2010. If no reply has been received I will assume your non-attendance.

Please accept, Mr. Minister, the assurances of my highest consideration.
